

PARENT CURRICULUM INFORMATION SUMMER TERM 2023 ANDREWS CLASS

Our school values and a strong ethos underpin all that we do. These values support the development of our children as reflective learners within a calm, caring, happy and purposeful atmosphere.



They are: Community, Independence, Respect, Health, Creativity, Resilience.

As scientists, the children will use the local environment
to discover more about native flora. They will learn to
identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants.

As athletes, the children will develop their jumping skills. This will include how to take-off and land, change speed and hop.

As historians, the children will be learning about the Wright brothers and their first aeroplane flight. They will explore the impact of this event and how it changed the world.

As team players, the children will develop their racket and ball skills. They will be challenged through a variety of hand eye coordination activities, as well as games designed to promote key attacking and defending strategies.

As technologists, the children will be looking at different mechanisms to make pop-up cards.

As artists, the children will explore different kinds of sculptures. They will make their own sculpture using natural objects similar to the style of artist Andy Goldsworthy.

As computer scientists, the children will become programmers and write their own algorithms. They will programme floor robots (Beebots) and create animations using Scratch Jr on iPads.

As musicians, the children will explore what it means to improvise. Later in the term, the children will reflect on all their musical knowledge and perform a story using instruments.

As citizens (P.S.H.E.), the children will develop their understanding of how to use coping strategies for different emotions and feelings. The children will also learn about computer safety and how to stay safe online.

As theologians (R.E), the children will be learning about Christians and the creation story. They will make links between Christianity and Judaism based on learning throughout the year.

As readers and writers, the children will develop their phonics knowledge continuing with the Read Write Inc scheme. They will develop their writing skills and apply them in forms of story writing, poetry and explanation texts. The children will also work on refining their cursive handwriting and spelling the year 1 common exception words.

As mathematicians, the children will be focusing on multiplication and division, fractions, time, money and consolidating shape and place value. They will learn the concept of multiplication and division using images and practical work to begin with. They will continue to secure counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and to know their number bonds to 20.
