Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal

Key Stage 2 Bags

Having canvassed the views of our parents last year, we have recently decided to allow all children in Key Stage 2 to bring in a rucksack should they choose. We have spoken to the children this week about the importance of taking responsibility for their belongings and only bringing in the <u>essential</u> items required for school – please speak to your child's class teacher if you require further clarification about this. All children in Key Stage 1, and those in Key Stage 2 who are not using a rucksack, should continue to use the school's purple bookbags.

Please see details below of the new certificates that we are awarding each week to celebrate successes in school.


- Our **Values Champion** certificate will be used to acknowledge the efforts of those children who have represented the school values through their actions.


