

**Parent Curriculum Information Sheet
Autumn Term 2023-24**

As readers and writers, children will continue reading for information and for pleasure across a wide range of text types as well as developing their control over writing through the use of e.g. punctuation to enhance or clarify the meaning of what they have written.

As mathematicians, children will further develop their understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages and the relationship between these. They will also work with a range of units of measurement and calculate the area and perimeter of different shapes. Children will also develop their understanding of algebra.

As scientists, children will learn about evolution and inheritance. They will learn about how living things have changed over time, how they produce offspring of the same kind and explore how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment.

As theologians (R.E.), the children will be building on their prior knowledge and skills relating to Hinduism. They will also look at the question, *'What do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people?'*

As geographers, children will investigate the world's different biomes. They will find out more about the climate, physical features, flora and fauna that can be found within these biomes.

As dancers, children will develop a range of movement patterns.

As netballers, children will learn to pass and move effectively to maintain possession of the ball.

As tag rugby players, children will develop their ability to pass, tackle, attack and defend.

As team players, children will develop their ability to work as a team and employ tactics.

As citizens (P.S.H.E.), the children will be building on their prior knowledge of how to stay healthy as well as looking at how we are responsible for our actions and the consequences of these. They will also learn and practice a range of first aid skills.

As computer scientists, the children will be building on their prior skills and knowledge by developing their programming skills using Scratch to create their own game. They will also develop their understanding of spreadsheets and how these are used.

As artists, the children will be building on their prior knowledge and skills in the medium of paint. They will practise forming tints, tones and shades and focus on painting portraits. They will complete an artist study of Picasso.

As technologists, children will use their knowledge of different sewing techniques to design and make a monogrammed sunglasses case.

As musicians, the children will be building on their prior knowledge and skills of structure and form as well as developing their confidence in musical notation and performance. Children will also be beginning to learn how to play the C clarinet.
