Parent Curriculum Information Sheet Summer Term 2023-24



Year 1

As readers and writers, the children will develop their phonics knowledge continuing with the Read Write Inc scheme. The children will develop their writing skills and apply them in forms of story writing, poetry and explanation texts. The children will also work on refining their cursive handwriting and continue to work on and progress through their spelling sheets.

As mathematicians, the children will be focusing on multiplication and division, fractions, time, money and consolidating shape and place value. They will learn the concept of multiplication and division using images and practical work to begin with. They will continue to secure counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and to know their number bonds to 20.

As scientists, the children will be learning about everyday materials - including naming and describing them. They will also continue to build on their season knowledge as we move through spring into summer.

As geographers, the children will be learning about the weather and how this can change in different locations. They will explore places that are hot and cold and look at extreme weather patterns. Our geography will link closely to our season work in science this term.

As historians, the children will be learning about the Wright brothers and the first ever aeroplane flight. They will explore how this significant event has changed people's lives and they will be able to place it accurately on a historical timeline.

As athletes, the children will develop their jumping skills – they will focus on take offs and landings, changing speed and hopping.

As team players, the children will be developing their racket and ball skills. They will develop their hand eye coordination along with attacking and defending skills through playing games.

As technologists, the children will be looking at different mechanisms such as sliders and leavers to make pop-up cards.

As artists, the children will look at different kinds of sculptures. They will make their own sculpture using natural objects in the style of the artist Andy Goldsworthy.

As computer scientists, the children will become programmers and write their own algorithms. The children will programme floor robots (Beebots) and create animations using Scratch Jr on an iPad.

As musicians, the children will explore what it means to improvise. Later in the term, they will reflect on the musical knowledge they have acquired to perform a story using instruments.

As citizens (PSHE), the children will discuss how to be responsible and how to watch out for and stay safe around hazards.

As theologians (R.E), the children will be learning about Christians and the creation story. They will also make links between Christianity and Judaism based on their learning throughout the year.
