As readers and writers, the children will build on their phonics knowledge from foundation, continuing with the Read Write Inc scheme. They will build on the sounds they already know, whilst learning new ones. They will become more independent in their writing beginning to learn cursive handwriting. As mathematicians, the children will primarily be focusing on number and place value. They will be learning to count and order numbers to 50 initially, as well as developing their understanding of the value of these numbers. A range of images will be used to support this. They will then move on to explore number facts within 10 and 20.

As scientists, the children will be learning about seasonal changes. They will be exploring what happens at different times of the year and how that impacts their lives.
