

**Parent Curriculum Information Sheet
Autumn Term 2024-2025**

As readers and writers, the children will be focussing on their grammar, spelling and punctuation skills daily. They will learn how to write both fiction and non-fiction pieces, with a focus on non-chronological reports, narratives and poetry. Every day, they will take part in a guided reading session, class read and independent read.

As mathematicians, children will initially be focussing on consolidating place value knowledge, with a focus on 2-digit numbers and 3-digit numbers. They will then be introduced to learning new key multiplication facts (3-, 4- and 8-times tables) and will learn the division facts that go with them.

As historians, the children will be learning about the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. They will develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of the changes that took place within this period. They will devise historically valid questions about change, cause, similarity and difference, whilst analysing a range of sources to help them form conclusions.

As theologians (R.E.), the children will explore what Christians believe about the Creation story. They will ask questions and suggest answers about what might be important in the Creation Story for Christians and non-Christians.

As scientists, the children will be exploring 'light' and its purpose. They will be taught to recognise the dangers of sunlight and develop their understanding of the concept of shadows and reflections.

In Mindfulness, the focus of the learning will be to consider how we feel in our minds and in our bodies, when we experience various emotions.

Within communication and tactics, children will focus their learning on what makes an effective team and how to create simple tactics together.

As team sports people, children will develop their ability to work as a team and employ specific tactics to games including netball and handball.

As citizens (P.S.H.E.), the children will begin by learning how to keep themselves and others safe. They will then learn how they can keep themselves healthy, both physically and mentally.

As computer scientists, the children will be learning how to stay safe online. They will then move on to multimedia text & images and look specifically at internet research and communication presentation skills.

As linguists, children will learn how to introduce themselves, how to say simple phrases and identify the names of different animals in French.

As technologists, the children will learn about designing with purpose as well as the history of pizza making. They will prepare ingredients hygienically and learn to measure ingredients accurately with a focus on a balanced and healthy product.

As musicians, children will explore a wide range of musical styles and songs, play instruments and develop their skills in listening, singing, composing, performing and improvising.
