
Parent Curriculum Information Sheet Autumn Term 2024-25





As readers and writers, the children will continue reading to learn new information and for pleasure across a wide range of text types. They will develop their writing in a range of styles to create varying effects for the reader.

As mathematicians, the children will deepen their understanding of place value, refine their calculation strategies in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and increase their depth of understanding relating to fractions.

As scientists, the children will learn about the properties of materials and how these can be altered through reversible and irreversible changes. They will also learn about different forces.

As theologians (R.E), the children will explore how God is holy and loving, as well as what it is like to be a Muslim in Britain today.

As historians, the children will learn about the lasting impact of the ancient Greek civilisation on the modern world (exploring democracy, theatre, and the Olympic Games).

As dancers, the children will design their own movements to portray athletes at the Olympic Games, as well as putting together movements to portray Greek gods and goddesses.

As team players, the children will learn how to develop a range of attacking and defending skills to help their team be successful in tag rugby and football. They will also develop their understanding of different tactics and a sense of fair play.

As citizens (PSHE), the children will learn about the effects of peer pressure (both positive and negative) as well as how to be inclusive and accepting of others. As computer scientists, the children will learn about computer systems and networks as well as learning how to optimise web searches. They will also learn how to create their own video media.

As linguists, children will learn to speak in French about familiar activities that they are or are not able to do. They will also learn to name different fruits and to describe what they do and do not like.

As technologists, the children will learn about different types of bread, how they are made and what constitutes a healthy diet.

As musicians, the children will learn about rock and jazz genres. As part of this, they will learn to accompany songs with instruments and compose their own music.
