As geographers, the children will be developing their understanding of our local area. They will look at a map of our school and draw their own using symbols. They will identify key human and physical features, finding these when undertaking a local walk.	 As athletes, the children will develop their jumping skills. This will include simple take off and landings, changing speed and hopping. As team players, the children will be developing their racket and ball skills. They will develop their hand eye coordination along with attacking and defending skills through games. 	
As technologists, the children will be looking at different mechanisms such as sliders and leavers to make pop-up cards.	As artists, the children will look at different kinds of sculptures. The children will make their own sculpture using natural objects in the style of the artist Andy Goldsworthy.	
As computer scientists, the children will learn to create and edit text using a keyboard and mouse while developing their understanding of computer use. They will also be introduced to basic programming concepts and algorithm design through Scratch Jr.	As musicians, the children will explore what it means to improvise. Later in the term, the children will reflect on all their musical knowledge and perform a story using instruments.	
As citizens (PSHE), the children will discuss how to be responsible and how to watch out for and stay safe around hazards.	As theologians (R.E), the children will be learning about Christians and the creation story. They will make links between Christianity and Judaism based on our learning throughout the year.	
As scientists, the children will be learning about everyday materials, naming and describing them. They will also continue to build on their seasonal knowledge as we move through spring into summer.		
As readers and writers, the children will develop their phonics knowledge continuing with the Read Write Inc scheme. The children will develop their writing skills and apply them in forms of story writing, poetry and explanation texts. The children will also work on refining their cursive handwriting and continue to work on and progress through their spelling sheets.
